



Seven Corners Awarded 13 Bureau of Prisons Contract Wins in 2019

CARMEL, IND. (Dec. 17, 2019) – [Seven Corners Inc.](#), an international travel insurance and specialty benefit management company, today reports unprecedented success in its [Bureau of Prisons \(BOP\) division](#), which was awarded 13 federal prison contract wins in 2019. Of the 13, eight were new contracts wins and five were renewals.

In total, Seven Corners holds 22 BOP contracts and services more than 30,264 federal inmates nationwide. Since its inception in 1993, the company has grown to service more than 1,000,000 customers each year including international travelers, federal inmates, U.S. government agencies, corporations, foreign governments and insurance companies.

Seven Corners was selected as the Comprehensive Medical Services contractor for inmates housed in the following institutions:

Federal Correctional Institution (FCI) Morgantown, West Virginia

This contract began on Jan. 1, 2019 and will continue through 2024. An all-male prison, FCI Morgantown houses approximately 1,035 inmates daily. FCI Morgantown is one of six federal prisons in the state of West Virginia.

Federal Prison Camp (FPC) Montgomery, Alabama

This contract began on Jan. 1, 2019 and will continue through 2024. An all-male prison, FPC Montgomery houses approximately 784 inmates daily. FPC Montgomery is one of four federal prisons in the state of Alabama.

FCI Talladega, Alabama

This contract began on April 22, 2019 and will continue through 2024. An all-male prison, FCI Talladega houses approximately 984 inmates daily.

United States Penitentiary (USP) Atwater, California

This contract began on June 1, 2019 and will continue through 2024. An all-male prison, USP Atwater houses approximately 1,035 inmates daily. USP Atwater is one of thirteen federal prisons in the state of California.

USP McCreary, Kentucky

This renewed contract began on July 1, 2019 and will continue through 2024. An all-male prison, FCI McCreary houses approximately 1,480 inmates daily. FCI McCreary is one of five federal prisons in the state of Kentucky.

FCI Ashland, Kentucky

This renewed contract began on Aug. 15, 2019 and will continue through 2024. An all-male prison, FCI Ashland houses approximately 1,213 inmates daily.

FCI Manchester, Kentucky

This renewed contract began on Oct. 1, 2019 and will continue through 2024. An all-male prison, FCI Manchester houses approximately 1,035 inmates daily. With the addition of FCI Manchester, Seven Corners now services three of the five federal prisons in the state of Kentucky.

FCI McDowell, West Virginia

This contract began on Oct. 1, 2019 and will continue through 2024. An all-male prison, FCI McDowell houses approximately 1,256 inmates daily. The contract marked the second facility awarded to Seven Corners this year in West Virginia.

Federal Department of Corrections (FDC) SeaTac, Washington

This renewed contract began on Oct. 1, 2019 and will continue through 2024. A male and female prison, FDC SeaTac houses approximately 731 inmates daily. FDC SeaTac is one of two federal prisons in the state of Washington.

FCI Dublin, California

This contract began on Dec. 1, 2019 and will continue through 2024. An all-female prison, FCI Dublin houses approximately 1,173 inmates daily.

FCI Estill, South Carolina

This renewed contract began on Dec. 1, 2019 and will continue through 2024. An all-male federal prison, FCI Estill houses approximately 1,234 inmates. FCI Estill is one of four federal prisons South Carolina.

FCI Terminal Island, California

This contract will begin on Jan. 1, 2020 and will continue through 2025. An all-male prison, FCI Terminal Island houses approximately 1,129 total inmates. The contract marked the third facility awarded to Seven Corners this year in California.

FCI Schuylkill, Pennsylvania

This contract will begin on Feb. 1, 2020 and will continue through 2025. An all-male prison, FCI Schuylkill houses approximately 1,264 total inmates. The contract marked the first facility awarded to Seven Corners this year in Pennsylvania.

As part of each contract, Seven Corners provides off-site health care services and manages provider relationships for each institution. All inmates receive quality care from a Comprehensive Provider Network, including Acute Care Centers, Ambulatory Surgery Centers, Long Term Acute Care Centers, Critical Access Hospitals and Specialty Physicians in their communities.
